Report of Expenditure

July-2021

Tri-lingual website in English, Urdu and Hindi languages was made live for benefit of target group, our donors, viewers, and for general public. In addition website ensures transparency in activities of foundation. Also we can receive regular feedback from our beneficiaries and general public for better service delivery.



Around 5000 cooked food packets, fruits and dairy products were distributed to children, women and other marginalised groups at different places to address their nutritional and healthy food needs. Fresh food packets around 200 were cooked and distributed on daily basis in different areas by some dedicated volunteers.



Water purifier and cooler of Voltas brand was distributed to Jamia Niswan girls School in sheikhpura district of Bihar for assuring accessible purified germ free water to girls studying there. Pertinent to mention it is an girls exclusive school.

Report of Expenditure



August -2021

During the month of August 2021 around 6000 fresh cooked food packets were distributed among poor children, women and elderly people in different localities of district sheikhpura Bihar. Total expenditure of these welfare activities was around rupees seventy thousand only.



September -2021

Around 4000 fresh cooked food packets were distributed among children and destitute women and elderly in different localities like streets, hospitals, etc.

Rupees 15000 were donated as school fees for education of school boy residing in Agra. Receipt of school account number attached in report. Total expenditure for welfare activities for month of September 2021 was approximately rupees eighty thousand only.

October -2021

Around 5000 fresh cooked food packets were distributed among children, women and destitute persons in different localities after field survey.

Rupees 15300 were donated to buy computer and other accessories for training of young children in basic computers in late Noor jahan trust Gaya Bihar.

Rupees 15000.00 (Fifteen thousand only) were donated to one poor person for treatment of his mother in Jammu and Kashmir based on his request application through mail and after verification.

Rupees 38000.00 (Thirty eight thousand only) were spent for meeting of minor expenses of marriage of one girl child from Aligarh after field verification.



November -2021

Around 5600 fresh cooked food packets were distributed in different places.

Help was provided to one accident patient in Bihar for meeting his medical expenses on basis of application through mail from his guardians.

Around rupees fifty thousand was spent for distributing blankets and dry rations in leper centre in Agra. During November end and December starting. (Photos uploaded on website).

December -2021

During December around 6000 fresh cooked food packets were distributed among children, women and destitute persons in different localities after field survey.



January -2022

During January 2022 around 5500 fresh cooked food packets were distributed.

Desks and benches were distributed in girls school in Agra. Name of school Madinatul Islam Agra.

Blankets distributed in Noorjahan Bibi Trust Gaya Bihar on the eve of Republic Day in different localities of Gaya.

February -2022

During the month around 5000 thousand fresh food packets were distributed in Different localities.

Rs. 1500/00 only (fifteen thousand only) were transferred to some poor patient Admitted in i.c.u medical college Kanpur. The transaction was made online.

Rs. 50000.00 (fifty thousand only) was transferred to submission school Bhopal M.P. For covering cost of breakfast of 250 students for one month. Fund was transferred.



March -2022

Sponsored ent operation of one poor girl in Bihar, approximate cost of treatment was Rs.31000.00 (thirty thousand only)
